

Care Coordinator Instructions Safe Disposal of Medications Member Handout

What this is:

- A new CMS regulation requires Medicare Advantage plans to provide members with written and verbal information about the safe disposal of prescription drugs that are controlled substances when conducting an <u>in-home</u> Health Risk Assessment (HRA) with a member. This includes identifying at least two local takeback sites in the member's community (see instructions below).
- **Exception:** The above is <u>not</u> required for members residing in an institutional setting where the institution has primary responsibility for disposal of residents' unused medications (e.g., nursing facility).

How it applies to you: Going forward, Care Coordinators must include the Medica Safe Disposal of Medications Handout along with the Medica Care Coordinator Leave-Behind Document whenever doing a face-to-face HRA visit with an MHSO or I-SNBC member. The safe disposal handout does <u>not</u> need to be provided to members who complete an HRA over the phone. It also is not required for MSC+ or SNBC members, but may be a helpful resource to provide them as well.

Instructions:

- 1. Prior to a face-to-face visit with an MSHO or I-SNBC member, download the Medica Safe Disposal of Medications Handout from the Medica Care Coordination website. It is located under Tools and Forms.
- Fill in the first page of the pdf with two takeback sites in the member's community. Identify takeback sites by going to the DEA's takeback site search engine at https://apps2.deadiversion.usdoj.gov/pubdispsearch/spring/main?execution=e1s1
 - a. Type in the member's zip code or city and state.
 - b. Choose a 5 mile search radius. If no sites are available within 5 miles, broaden your search to 10 miles and further until the search returns at least two sites.
- 3. During the face-to-face visit with the member, provide a verbal summary of the information in the handout and leave the handout with the member along with the Leave Behind Document.
- Document in case notes that you provided verbal and written information to the member about the safe disposal of prescription drugs <u>and</u> left the Safe Disposal of Medications Handout and Leave Behind Document with the member.
