Benefits Defined

This Special Supplemental Benefit for the Chronically Ill (SSBCI) provides access to web-based education program Cell-ED on life skills such as practical math and safe online browsing provided by Pearson.

Covered Services

Up to 12 months of access to the Cell-ED web-based education program per plan year.

Eligibility:

- Member has been identified through Medica monthly claims review with one or more of the following chronic conditions:
 - Diabetes
 - Congestive Heart Failure
 - Hypertension
 - Ischemic Heart Disease

Process

- Program must be Cell-ED provided by Pearson.
- Members register online by navigating to www.pearsonaccelerated.com/Medica/ and selecting the MSHO plan
 - Care Coordinators can provide assistance to members with this process as needed
- Members register using their Medica Member ID and Date of birth
 - Members are asked to create a username and password at the time of registration
 - Login should be recorded for future reference by the member
- Members access Cell-ED on a computer or mobile app (Apple App Store or Google Play)

- If a member has technical difficulties the Cell-ED website has technical support
