- Network Navigators to answer questions about your providers, connect you with care, and work closely with Medica as your advocate.
- Same-day appointment options at most primary clinics, along with convenient Saturday morning appointments at select clinics.
- **Ridgeview eCare**, which lets you get an online diagnosis, treatment, or even a prescription if you need one.
- MyChart, a secure online portal that lets you direct message your provider, schedule or request appointments, view most test results, and more. Sign up at RidgeviewMedical.org/MyChart.

If your student is seeking care outside the Ridgeview Community Network service area but within Medica's service area of Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota, and western Wisconsin, emergency care services will be covered at the in-network benefit level. For other health care services, they will need to access care from a Ridgeview Community Network provider for in-network benefits to apply.

Ridgeview Community Network is an accountable care organization (ACO). What that means is simple: We partner with a group of doctors, hospitals, and other health care providers to give you high-quality care at a lower cost.
