YOUR ID CARD CONTAINS IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Doctors, pharmacists and other providers need this information to serve you and correctly bill Medica for services you receive. Be sure to carry it with you at all times because you'll need it when you:

Visit a clinic, hospital or pharmacy

Require emergency care

Need to call Customer Service or 24 hour nurse line

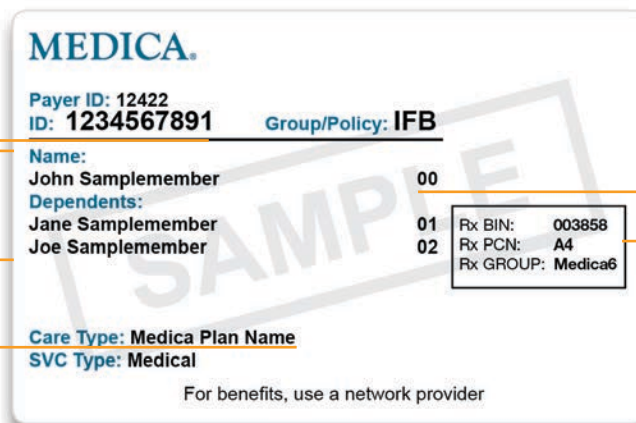
ID number. This ID number, assigned by Medica, is unique to your policy.

Covered members. Each family member covered under the plan is listed under the subscriber's name. The subscriber is the person with primary responsibility for the coverage.

Care type. The name of your Medica plan and network.

Claims. Use these addresses to submit paper claims (used mostly by providers).

Customer Service phone number. Call this number when you have questions about your plan.



Member ID number. This two-digit number is used with your ID number to identify a specific member (for example, John Samplmember's unique member ID number is 123456789100).

Pharmacy information. Your pharmacy will use this information to submit your claims.

The Front of Your Card



Medica Behavioral Health Services. Call this number if you have questions about Behavioral Health claims or providers.

Nurse line phone number. Call this number for 24 hour advice from a registered nurse.

The Back of Your Card

Note: Your actual ID card may look different than the card shown above.

USE YOUR ID CARD TO REGISTER FOR YOUR MEMBER SITE

You'll need information found on your Medica ID card to register for your secure member site on **MedicaMember.com**. When registering, provide the information exactly as it appears on your Medica ID card.

Your secure member site is your one-stop resource for the information you need to manage your health plan benefits and help improve your health. It takes just a few minutes to register for the site. Register and you can:

- » View your ID card
- » See what's covered by your plan, including important plan documents
- » Track your plan balances, such as your deductible and out-of-pocket maximum
- » Track your claims and explanations of benefits (EOBs)
- » Look up prices for prescriptions
- » Wellness tools and support
- » Check to see if a doctor or other health care provider is in your plan's network
- » Pay your premium

KEEP IN MIND

Have your ID card handy when you call Customer Service.

If you need extra ID cards, log in to your secure member site on **MedicaMember.com** where you can order additional cards or print a temporary ID card.

If you renew your coverage with Medica and your plan changes, you'll receive a new ID card.
