- **ID:** This number is unique to you (and your family members, if applicable). You and your dependents have the same 10-digit ID.
- **Group/Policy #:** This number identifies your specific medical plan.
- Covered Members: The subscriber is the person with primary responsibility for the coverage. Each dependent covered under the medical plan is listed under the subscriber's name. Each dependent age 16 years and older will receive their own ID card.
- 4. Care Type: The name of your medical plan and network where you receive the highest level of benefits. You can find a physician or facility by going to Medica.com/MemberSite.
- Service (SVC) Type: The type of coverage offered.
- **Pharmacy Information:** Your pharmacy will use this information to submit your claims.

- Medica Behavioral Health Services: Call this number when you need access to behavioral health services or have a question about a behavioral health claim.
- Medica Customer Service: Call this number when you have questions about your medical plan, drug coverage and prescriptions.

- **14. Pharmacists:** Your pharmacy can call this number for help with your prescriptions.
- 15. Providers: Your providers can call this number or go to this website if they need help with your medical plan or benefits.
- 16. Network Logos: These are additional networks included with your medical plan. To see if a provider is included in your network, log in to Medica.com/ MemberSite or call Medica Customer Service.
