Review Criteria

MEDICA®

Question

1. Is there documentation that the patient has been asked about ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION, including the quantity, in the past year?
2. If there is documentation that the patient drinks alcohol, has there been an assessment for problem drinking by the use of a formal screening questionnaire?
3. Is there documentation that the patient has been assessed for DEPRESSION symptoms by use of a depression assessment tool in the past year?
4. There is evidence the female member up-to-date with PAP screening and/or PAP and HPV screening?
5. There is evidence that the member is up-to-date with their COLONOSCOPY screening.
6. There is evidence that the member is up-to date with MAMMOGRAM screening.
7. Is there evidence in the medical record that the patient does or does not have an ADVANCE DIRECTIVE?
8. If the member does not have an advance directive, there is documentation of an advance care planning discussion during the last year and the date on which it was discussed.
